WHAT IS ROTATION SUNDAY SCHOOL?

In the Workshop-Rotation model, rooms are set up as specific activity centers rather than the traditional classrooms.

Major Bible stories and concepts are taught through kid-friendly multi-media workshops of: art, cooking, computer, drama, mission, games and movies.

The same Bible story is taught for four to six weeks rotating the kids to a different workshop each week. Your child will rotate through each "station" learning the Bible lesson through different experiences and activities.

Children are divided by age group and a "Shepherd" will remain with each age group through the year. The Shepherd will get to know your children and will be assisting them though each of the stations.
